This is 6th phase of UWEZO AWARD since it's inception in 2016 and we are proud to grow bigger and stronger. So far the project has reached over 420 Secondary Schools of Dar es Salaam and Coastal Region. In UWEZO AWARD 2021, Great Hope Foundation has involved schools in Morogoro as well.



#### **UWEZO AWARD 2021 Progress**

GHF has reached 214 schools out of 180 target and many schools have started doing their community change Projects from Dar Es Salaam, Coastal region and Morogoro as summarized in the table below.

Volunteers are working tirelessly to inspire these students to kickstart their Community Change Projects so that we can increase participation to 80% from 50% in 2020.
