Why Uwezo Bonanza?

For the first time this year, Great Hope Foundation (GHF) organized UWEZO BONANZA, an event for students to showcase their talents competitively. The project has been added on top of UWEZO AWARD project, because as GHF team was collecting feedback from students, it was observed that they needed another platform that will make them meet their fellows from other schools and showcase their talents.

They have been doing these talents showcase at school, now they wanted a bigger event that shall bring all of them together. UWEZO BONANZA 2021 was held at DUCE (Dar es Salaam University College of Education) on 14th October, 2021 bringing together over 1000 students from more than 100 Secondary Schools of Dar es Salaam and Coastal Region.

PREPARATION FOR UWEZO BONANZA

Preparation for UWEZO BONANZA started in May, 2021 where students were requested to send videos of their performances in areas they wish to showcase their talents. OUR EVENT PANELISTS


The day had three panelists who carefully observed all performances and gave some remarks so that at the end of the day, GHF could have winners who will go home with trophies.
















JUDGES SHARED THEIR REMARKS AT THE END OF ALL PERFORMANCES.
