

She took the students towards the whole journey that brought Sustainable Development Goals from Millennium Development Goals. She trained on all the 17 goals and helped students to understand, how these goals fall in four categories: People, Planet, Peace, Prosperity and Partnership.

At the end Certificates were given to all participants from the six Municipalities. Students and teachers, both were recognized as SDGs Champions, and inspiring them to speak about SDGs to other people.



To end the day, Didi Nafisa appreciated all participants on their participation and asked them to spread the word about SDGs. Noelle Mahuvi appreciated participation of all teachers and students, and asked students to share on their UWEZO AWARD 2019 reports, the type of SDGs they have chosen to work on as they were working on Community Change Project. Also she asked them to share their experience and lessons gathered on that particular goal. Noelle insisted that they shall follow up on each school to hear the stories that students have been able to do on their project with knowledge of SDGs.
